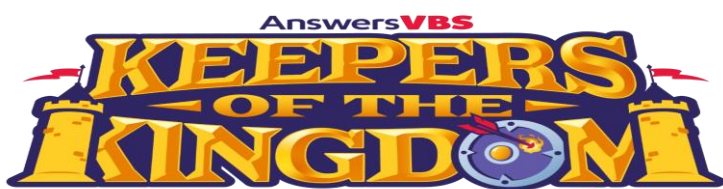

**\*LENTEN REGULATIONS**-All Fridays of Lent (except  
**Friday March 17<sup>th</sup> St. Patrick's Day, make another sacrificial  
or charitable act this day**) are obligatory days of abstinence-  
(means we do not eat meat). The law of fast binds everyone from  
age 18-59. Good Friday is an obligatory day of fast & abstinence-  
means we have only one full meal a day. Two lighter meals are  
permitted. We do not eat meat this day also. The law of  
abstinence binds from age 14 & older. Those that are excused are  
the physically and mentally ill including those suffering from  
chronic illness, diabetes, pregnant or nursing mothers.

pressurized paths of darkness?

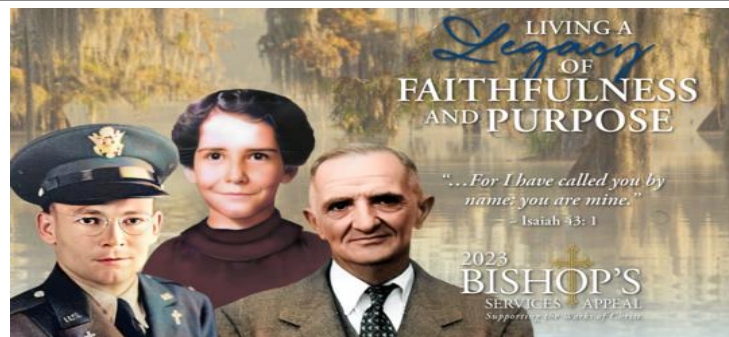
