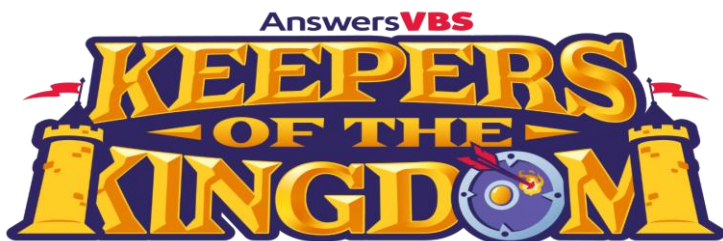

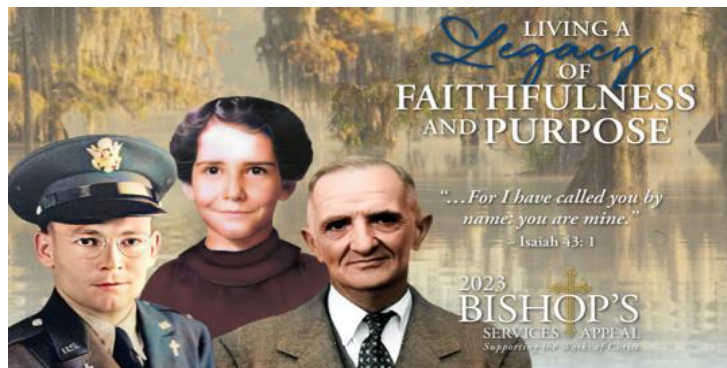

Reflection on the Gospel-The mystery of God that all three
readings proclaim is love—and love is never solitary, never static
or finished. Theology has tried to express this idea in the word
perichoresis or “dance/choreography.” Choreography suggests
dynamic, mobile partnership: encircling, encompassing,
permeating, enveloping, outstretching. As theologian Catherine
Mowry LaCugna writes: “There are neither leaders nor followers
in the divine dance, only an eternal movement of reciprocal giving
and receiving, giving again and receiving again....The image of
the dance forbids us to think of God as solitary.”
