MASS FOR THIS WEEKEND-Without capacity limitations the majority of congregants will be sitting closer to one another. As such, the wearing of masks remains very important (except young children and those with respiratory difficulties). The Church doors will be opened 30 minutes before mass. Maintain 6 feet safe distancing at all times. The Gifts will not be brought up at this time. **The middle side back pews will be corded off if you want to social distance.**

For Communion Time- Use hand sanitizer before you receive communion, please bring your own or use bottle in back of church. One row at a time-Parishioners to go out one by one with 6 feet distance in between. *Receive Communion in the hands.
*Parishioners are not to socialize in church. You may visit outside after Mass away from exits and should be encouraged to physically distance and to wear masks.

If you are sick, please attend only when you are well. Also, persons over 65 years old are at a higher risk of experiencing worse symptoms than others if they contact the coronavirus and should consider not attending Mass.

*Phase 3 also-All Catholics in the Diocese of Lafayette remain dispensed from their obligation from attending Sunday Masses until we get word from Bishop Deshotel. The duty to sanctify Sunday should be fulfilled through some other form of devotion, watch mass on television or on the internet, pray the rosary, scripture reading, etc.
