Reflection on the Gospel-This Sunday’s gospel is again an
“epiphany,” a manifestation of Jesus’s glory, chosen not from
Luke’s but from John’s gospel. For the Eastern church, the
showing to the Magi, the baptism of Jesus, and the wedding feast
of Cana were all celebrated at Epiphany as aspects of Jesus’s
manifestation. This tradition is preserved in the Western church
by today’s remembrance. By changing water into wine at the
wedding feast in Cana of Galilee, Jesus gives the first of the
Johannine signs that are to confirm his disciples’ faith in him.
