Good Friday is an obligatory day of fast and abstinence-means we have only one full meal a day. Two lighter meals are permitted. We do not eat meat this day also. The law of abstinence binds from age 14 and older. Those that are excused are the physically and mentally ill including those suffering from chronic illness, diabetes, pregnant or nursing mothers. **Ash Wednesday is not a Holy Day of Obligation.**

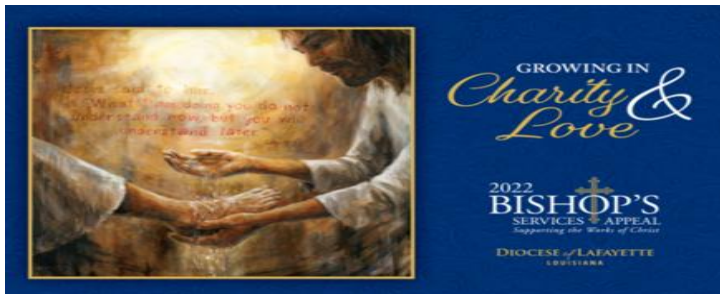

**Reflection on the Gospel**-The good teacher, the wise parent, often makes a point by exaggeration, as does Jesus in some of his parables, including the mini-parables in this reading. Some of us would have no trouble winning a black belt for innuendo and faint praise, so quick are we on the offensive against others, and even faster on the defensive about ourselves.
