**Reflection on the Gospel**-The parable of the Prodigal Son can be  
regarded as the gospel in miniature. In giving his sons their

welcome his son back home, the father again shows his foolish,  
costly love: there is no cool, reserved reception of his son, but a  
running welcome, a kiss, an embrace. The parable shows us that  
God is also prodigal—a spendthrift with his love for each one of
