Good Friday is an obligatory day of fast and abstinence-means we have only one full meal a day. Two lighter meals are permitted. We do not eat meat this day also. The law of abstinence binds from age 14 & Older. Those that are excused are the physically & mentally ill including those suffering from chronic illness, diabetes, pregnant or nursing mothers.

MASS FOR THIS WEEKEND-Without capacity limitations the majority of congregants will be sitting closer to one another. As such, the wearing of masks remains very important (except young children and those with respiratory difficulties). The Church doors will be opened 30 minutes before mass. Maintain 6 feet safe distancing at all times. The Gifts will not be brought up at this time. **The middle aisles-back pews will be corded off if you want to social distance.**

For Communion Time- Use hand sanitizer before you receive communion, please bring your own or use bottle in back of church. One row at a time-Parishioners to go out one by one with 6 feet distance in between. *Receive Communion in the hands.
*Parishioners are not to socialize in church. You may visit outside after Mass away from exits and should be encouraged to physically distance and to wear masks.

If you are sick, please attend only when you are well. Also, persons over 65 years old are at a higher risk of experiencing worse symptoms than others if they contact the coronavirus and should consider not attending Mass.

*Phase 3 also-All Catholics in the Diocese of Lafayette remain dispensed from their obligation from attending Sunday Masses until we get word from Bishop Deshotel. The duty to sanctify Sunday should be fulfilled through some other form of devotion, watch mass on television or on the internet, pray the rosary, scripture reading, etc.

Reflection on the Gospel-By visiting Jesus at night, Nicodemus avoids the daylight that might reveal him as associating with a man who is unpopular with the religious institution. To be unafraid or unashamed of professing our friendship with Jesus by the way we live always brings hard demands. We often prefer the false safety of darkness to the light of Christ that exposes, for example, our selfish, racist, sexist, or violent selves. Lent is designed to drag us out of darkness into the Easter light of Christ through prayer, fasting, and almsgiving.
