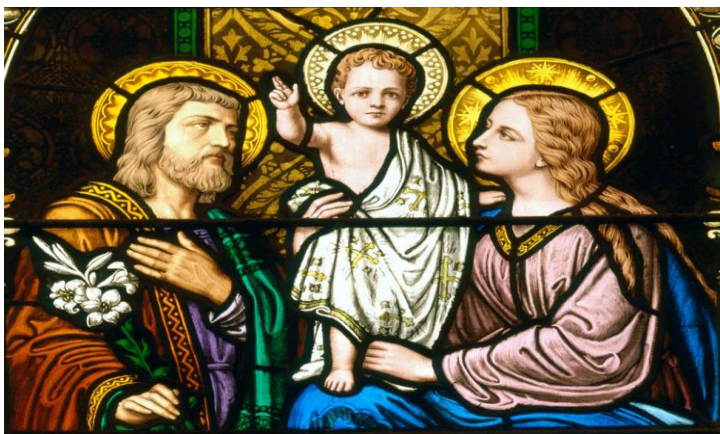

Reflection on the Gospel-Jesus’s command to seat the crowd in a hundred groups of fifty is an image of the local churches gathered as the church universal. Luke wants his community, and all hearers of the Gospel, to connect this meal with the feeding traditions of his ancestors; the miraculous mana in the wilderness (Exod 16) and the story of Elisha feeding a crowd with loaves of bread, some of which were left over (2 Kgs 4). Into this past, the present of the Gospel Bethsaida and all our eucharistic “Bethsaidas” are gathered.
