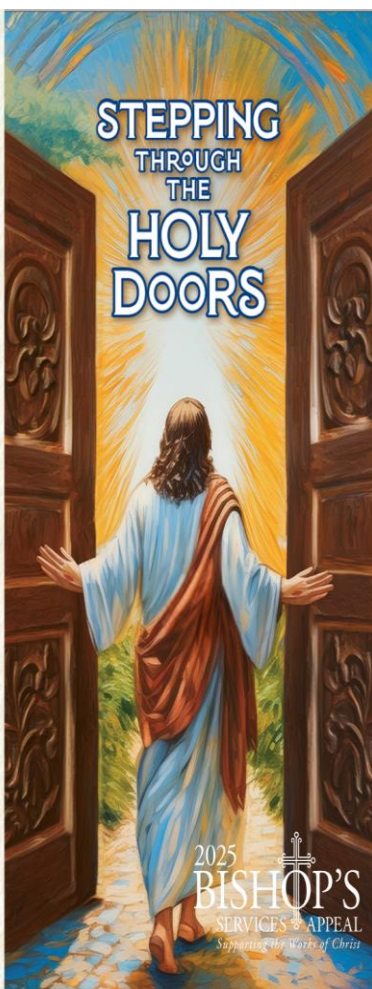

Reflection on the Gospel-

“Scripture scholar Stephen Bevens has elaborated a missionary
theology of the Spirit, naming it “God Inside Out.” Today’s gospel
says that this Spirit now rests upon Jesus, who makes humanly
visible and tangible the inner heart of God, who desires healing,
wholeness, and jubilee justice. Luke says that “the eyes of all in
the synagogue looked intently” at Jesus when he read from the
prophet Isaiah. Could they see “God inside out” as he
interpreted the Scripture passage as fulfilled in their hearing?
