RELIGIOUS EDUCATION NEWS- This coming session will consist of Homeschool lessons each month and 1 class per month. ***Elementary students: 1st, 3rd, 4th & 5th grades will come on the Second Sunday of the month, Mass at 9am and then class after from 10am to 11am at the Hall.** These Elementary Students will start Sunday, September 8th.

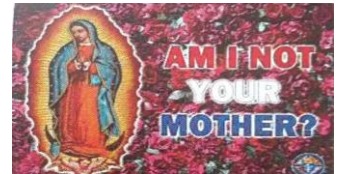
