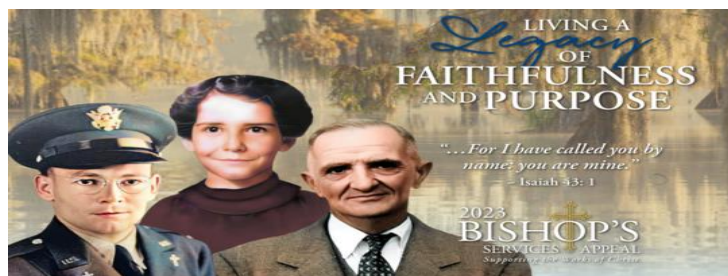
Reflection on the Gospel-A dragnet was a large net supported by
